

COLLEGE ADMISSION RULES FOR FOREIGNERS AND STATELESS PERSONS

One of the college's priorities is integration into the international educational space. An important part of such integration is the training of foreign citizens in the following educational and professional programs:

- Navigation and Seagoing Ship's Handling;
- Ship's Engineering Systems and Complexes Operation and Management;
- Transport Technology (Sea and River Transport);
- Operation of Mechanical and Automated Reloading

The college accepts foreign students who have completed secondary education, without restrictions based on race, skin color, political, religious, or other beliefs, gender, ethnic or social origin, financial status, place of residence, language, or other factors. The college enrolls foreign citizens in an full-time study and part-time study form of education for an educational and professional degree— Junior Bachelor. Foreigners are educated on a both full-time study and part-time study basis under the terms of an agreement on the provision of educational services at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities. Duration of study: 2 years and 10 months.

Candidates who do not speak Ukrainian can take language training courses to ensure that they achieve the level of knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary for further study of professional educational programs in Ukrainian, learn about the history of Ukraine and the traditions of the college, and consolidate their knowledge of general education disciplines. Based on their academic performance and final test results, our graduates receive a certificate that allows them to continue their studies at the college or any other educational institution.

DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION

To enter Ukraine on a visa, applicants must obtain an invitation to study, for which they must submit the following information to the college or partner company: surname and first name, date of birth, series and number of national passport, citizenship, country of visa issuance. The invitation to study is issued personally to the applicant or to the partner company. If a foreigner applies through a representative, this information must be indicated in the application.

To apply for admission, foreign students create an electronic user account in the Unified System, where they submit an electronic application to the college to generate an electronic invitation.

The foreigner shall attach electronic copies of the following documents to the application via the Unified System:

- a valid document confirming the degree (level) of education obtained by a foreigner abroad, on the basis of which admission is carried out, and an appendix to it (if the existence of an appendix is provided for by the legislation of the country of origin of the document);

- valid academic certificate issued by a foreign/Ukrainian institution of higher or pre-higher education (in case of transfer or resumption of studies starting from the second year);
- passport document of a foreigner or document certifying the identity of a stateless person;
- a copy of the birth certificate;
- color digitalized image of a person's face.

Based on the results of the analysis of the validity of the education document(s), the Department for the Training of Foreign Students and Distance Learning provides a conclusion on its results, which is entered into the Unified System.

Passports, educational documents, and birth certificates must be certified in their country of origin in the manner officially used in that country for such certification (consular legalization, including legalization by the relevant foreign institution of Ukraine, or affixing an apostille for countries that are parties to the Convention abolishing the requirement of legalization of foreign official documents), except for documents issued in Ukraine.

To enroll in the college, a foreigner must personally submit a paper application to the admissions committee.

The foreigner shall attach to the application:

- 1) a document (original and copy) confirming the previously obtained educational (educational and qualification) level on the basis of which admission is carried out;
- 2) an appendix (original and copy) to the document on the previously obtained educational (educational and qualification) level, on the basis of which admission is carried out (if available);
- 3) an academic transcript (if available) issued by a foreign/Ukrainian educational institution (in case of transfer or resumption of studies starting from the second year, an academic transcript shall be attached);
- 4) a copy of the foreigner's passport or document certifying the stateless person's identity;
- 5) 12 photographs 30 x 40 mm in size;
- 6) a copy of the foreign Ukrainian's certificate (if available).

Enrollment of foreigners and stateless persons is possible if they have completed secondary education outside of Ukraine.

The order for enrollment of a foreigner in the College is carried out under the conditions specified in the educational offer accepted by the foreigner. The relevant educational offer is an integral part of the contract for the provision of educational services concluded by the foreigner.

Foreign students study and have the same rights and obligations as Ukrainian students.

Foreign students are entitled to a place in the college dormitory and participate in the social, sporting, and cultural life of the institution.

The college believes it has a significant responsibility and role in educating young people. Educational work among students is carried out jointly with the deputy head of the college for educational work, the head of the department, and the

department methodologist. It is based on the priority promotion of universal human values, the development and improvement of the effectiveness of individual work in all areas, and the humanization and humanization of education.

The college (dormitory) staff includes special operational teams that ensure student safety and maintain law and order.

At the college, legal awareness is promoted by the deputy head of the college for educational and training work, department heads, and study group supervisors in accordance with the decisions of operational meetings of the leadership of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine and the Ministry of Education and Science, as well as plans for interdepartmental measures to improve the fight against crime.

Excursions around the city, visits to museums and exhibitions, and theater performances are regularly organized for students. Interviews with students are held on a regular basis, to which leading experts in the maritime industry are invited.

The college does not cover the costs of registration, visas, accommodation, meals, or travel within Ukraine and abroad in any case.

The college has no obligations regarding the arrival and stay of students' families in Ukraine and does not provide them with accommodation.
